Jez Danks presents Eddy's Christmas Cracker at Aberystwyth Arts Centre on Thursday 17th December at 7.45pm.

After standing in at the very last minute for Jez Danks' recent show at the Aberystwyth Arts Centre, Eddy's career has taken off in a big way: a whirlwind tour of South Wales' top social clubs, a weekly slot on Radio Bynea's 'How's it goin' - even rumours of a world tour...

But has it all become too much for this ex-factory worker from the Valleys? Eddy talks frankly about the highs and lows of showbiz, fearlessly tackles life's big issues, and asks if fame may sometimes come at too high a price.

Since the 1960's Jez Danks has worked as a composer, instrumentalist, teacher and performer. Jez has become a regular fixture at Aberystwyth Arts Centre. The success of his first one man show 'Wok in Progress' (2005) led to his being invited back for two more sell-out performances later the same year. Subsequent shows – 'Rom Service', 'Panting by Numbers', 'Cross Incontinents', 'Nil by Moth' – have all proved equally popular. Jez's works are all original, containing improvised monologues, songs and instrumental music, which he both composes and performs.
