A Welsh Night With Catrin and Friends is a special fundraising concert for Beacon of Hope, of which Catrin Finch is a patron. The concert will take place at Aberystwyth Arts Centre on Thursday 17 June, 8pm.

Described as “The Queen of Harps”, Catrin Finch has delighted audiences with her performances in the UK and worldwide. Inspired to learn the harp at the age of five, her rise to prominence started almost immediately, achieving the highest mark in the UK for her Grade VIII exam at the age of nine. Using electric harps, state of the art technology and ground-breaking sound effects, her latest project reinvigorates some of Wales's most traditional folk tunes. Known for her work within the community and with the younger generation, Catrin is committed to promoting the harp and classical music in general to a new and wider audience.
