Neil Callaghan & Simone Kenyon present their latest performance, *Piece Now*, at Aberystwyth Arts Centre on Thursday 4th February, 8.30pm.

Beginning with Alan Clarke's 1989 film 'Elephant' as a central reference point, *Piece Now* is a dance performance that explores death and the coldness of killing. Through tense, pedestrian choreography a couple reconstruct and question ideas of what a body is through becoming multiple bodies and returning to moments of fatal actions.

Neil Callaghan & Simone Kenyon are one of the first Performing Arts Companies in Residence at Aberystwyth Arts Centre, and this will be the first time they present their new work to the public. The residency has given an opportunity for the artists to develop individual artistic practice, and to exchange ideas in a creative atmosphere with people from other disciplines.
