Due to popular demand, Mick Perrin for Just For Laughs Live is proud to present Reginald D Hunter's latest show on a 55 date tour of the UK, touring to Aberystwyth Arts Centre on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> May, 8pm.

A regular performer at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe since 2002, Reginald's career has led to him being invited to perform in venues the world over in places such as Singapore, Hong Kong, Thailand and South Africa. He is one of the few performers to have been nominated for the Perrier Award in three consecutive years. His debut Edinburgh show in 2002, *I Said What I Said* was nominated for the Perrier Best Newcomer Award and his next two shows (*White Woman* in 2003 and *A Mystery Wrapped In A Nigga* in 2004) both received Perrier Award nominations. In 2006, as well as performing in America for the first time, Reginald won The Writers' Guild Award for Comedy for his show *Pride And Prejudice And Niggas*, which he then presented for a season in London's West End and on a national tour of the UK.

He has performed at Sydney Opera House and has just returned from an appearance at the Sydney Comedy Festival and his second appearance at the Melbourne Comedy Festival. He is also a well-known face on primetime television shows such as *8 Out Of 10 Cats*, *Never Mind The Buzzcocks* and *QI* and is a frequent guest on *Have I Got News For You*. He has recently appeared in *Argumental* for Dave Channel and *Would I Lie To You* for BBC1. He has also just finished starring alongside Andy Hamilton in BBC4's *It's Only A Theory* and appeared most recently in the New Years Day episode of the hugely popular *Live At The Apollo* (BBC1)

His eclectic mix of quirky anecdotes and witty one-liners has earned him legions of fans across the U.K., as well as recent performances on *Michael McIntyre’s Comedy Roadshow* (BBC1), *Comedy Cuts* (ITV), *The Live Floor Show* (BBC2), *The Comedy Store* and *Comedy Blue* (Paramount), and *The World Stands Up!* (Comedy Central).
