Argentina's hottest tango show returns to the UK

**Direct from Buenos Aires, Argentina's hottest dance show
Tango Fire tours the UK this autumn, performing at
Aberystwyth Arts Centre on Saturday 3rd October, 8pm.**

Following two sell-out shows at the Peacock Theatre at Sadler's Wells (2007 & 2009), this sizzling show takes to the road with 10 sensational dancers accompanied by Quatrotango, a quartet of brilliant musicians. This is tango at its fiery best.

Tango Fire is an irresistible journey through the history of this most seductive of dance forms. Period duets evoke the glitter and danger of the barrios where the dance was born, and the heady nostalgia of the early dance halls where it was popularised, while the group's modern choreography is edged with the sharpness and sophistication of contemporary Argentina.

This show is in a true dance spectacular. The company of 5 couples, each with their own sultry moods, moves and rhythms, perform breathtaking duets and dazzling group numbers that ooze sophistication and sass. The dancers are Yanina Fajar and Nelson Celis; Victoria Saudelli and Sebastian Alvarez; Ines Cuesta and Mauricio Celis; Florencia Roland and Juan Malizia; and Teresita Sanchez Terraf and German Cornejo.

Quatrotango, a quartet of brilliant young musicians, provide the live music, expertly combining the nostalgic tradition of tango with a contemporary cutting edge and blend the traditional instruments of tango: bandoneon (Hugo Sattore), piano (MD Gabriel Clenar), violin (Marcelo Rebuffi) and double bass (Gerardo Scaglione). The band and the dancers will be accompanied by a live singer who will be announced later this summer.

Forget Strictly – this is the real thing! It's a perfect night out for all dance-lovers, and a brilliant opportunity to introduce friends and family to the passion of Tango. So get set for some steamy,



sensual and stunning South American passion as the show takes you on an irresistible journey through the history of one of the most popular dance forms ever.
