Lyngo Theatre will perform *What A Wonderful World* at Aberystwyth Arts Centre on Sunday 4th October at 2.30pm.

Lyngo Theatre take their audience on a dream holiday, invite them to hide their faces amid a crowd of stars, and discover fire all over again. In this highly interactive show for the early years audiences can dance to live music, throw snowballs and get their hands on the stuff of creation.

Italy's Lyngo Theatre knows the score when it comes to producing theatre for the very young (from age two). *What A Wonderful World* is Lyngo's third show in a trilogy of early years work: a creation story with music, songs and judicious use of intriguing goody bags, soft pillows, mirrors and miles of hessian to roll about on.

Patrick Lynch, of CBeebies' Razzledazzle fame, and Emilia Brodie, with her violin and alto recorder, play Mr Armstrong and Necessity, Mother of Invention, respectively. Mindful of the selective attention of their infant audience, their dialogue is interspersed with jolly invitations - to chase stars or pop bubble wrap. Activities are accompanied by composer Carlo Cialdo Capelli's sweet ostinato overlaid with message-affirming lyrics.
