

Aberystwyth Arts Centre's Ian McKellen Award - Full Terms and Conditions 2020

1. The Award is open to any young person between the ages of 16 – 25 who is intending to continue their vocational training in the creative arts – including, but not limited to, theatre, dance and the visual arts.
2. The Award is aimed at young people age 16 - 25 who can demonstrate artistic promise and the passion for their artform, and who are in receipt of a place for study during the following academic year.
3. Applicants must apply to Aberystwyth Arts Centre by **7 August 2020** using the official application form.
4. Applicants will be required to attend a short interview to discuss their application during **August 2020**.
5. The Awarding Panel will meet to decide upon the allocations in August 2020; the decision of the Awarding Panel is final.
6. The value of the Award is £500. The Panel may choose to offer the full amount to one candidate, or to share between two successful applicants. The Award is for one year only. The payment will be made direct to the recipient's bank account
7. One Award is available for 2020 entry.
8. The Scholarship holder will be required to submit a report at the end of the year of study to indicate how the course has benefited them. The Arts Centre would be keen to maintain contact throughout study and beyond, and to offer ongoing mentoring support if that would be beneficial for the individual.
9. Failure to meet any of the above requirements will result in the Award being withdrawn.
